Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met on Tuesday, September 6, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Curry, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary. Tynes called the meeting to order and a quorum was established. Wgner led the invocation and Tynes followed with the pledges.

The Court declared the meeting open to the public for hearing on the Proposed Tax Rate for 2022, which is .3783.

The first speaker was W. T. Paul, who complained that his taxes would go up 36%, even with all his exemptions.

The next speaker was Richard Layne who stated that the Texas Legislature and the Texas State Comptroller had taken the power from the counties in an effort to force the counties to accept full responsibility for funding schools.

The Court took no action on Agenda item 4.

Tynes explained the FY2022-2023 proposed budget deficit regarding revenues received in FY2021-2022, and expenses for FY2022-2023.
