Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: County Judge James Yates, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Lloyd Huggins, Keith Curry and Dickie Clary. County Judge James Yates called the meeting to order a quorum was established. Judge Yates led the invocation and all followed with the pledges.

The Commissioners Court took action on the Interlocal Cooperation Contract for Hamilton County Child Protective Services and Hamilton County. The contract begins October 1, 2023



The revised bid total is \$48,500.00 and should begin construction in roughly 90 days. Commissioner Huggins made a motion to approve the bid and Commissioner Curry seconded the motion. The court approved the bid with a 4-0 vote, Judge Yates abstained.
