Position Summary:

- Responsible for the care, custody, and control of persons to include the safety of inmates while in the care, custody, and control of County Sheriff; releasing offenders, maintaining security of the facility, and escorting offenders within and/or outside the secure confines of the jail. He/She will maintain order and security through fair and impartial application of Comanche County Jail Policies and Procedures.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Current Valid Texas Driver's License
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Never Convicted of a Crime: Class B misdemeanor or Higher
- Any level Class Misdemeanor or Felony involving Family Violence will not be considered.
- Must Pass a background check
- Must Pass a Reading Comprehension Test
- Must Pass a Physical exam
- Must Pass a Psychological Exam
- Ability to work any shift including nights, weekends and holidays with varying days off.

Applicants will go through phases to be considered for employment: background check, interview and Conditional Offer of Employment. The Conditional Offer of Employment is not a guarantee of employment but another testing phase for consideration of the job performances.

All training required will be hands on taught locally with Obtainment of permanent jailer license thru TCOLE within a year of being awarded temporary license.

1. All officers are required to attend a 3-1/2 week course at the West Central Texas Law Enforcement Academy for Jailer/Detention Officer certification by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE). Upon successful completion of the Academy and state exam, Certified Jail/Detention officer status is attained.
