The Comanche County Sheriff's Office Jail has worked with the Local Health Authority and Texas Commission on Jail Standards to resume Inmate Visitation. The plan provides for continued health and safety of the Inmates and Staff while addressing the safety of the public.

Each housing dorm has a set time on each of the four days Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. The scheduled times will alternate between mornings and afternoons on the four days to allow for visitors work schedules. This allows for bi-weekly weekend mornings and afternoon rotation. For example if the inmate is scheduled on Saturday morning this week the following Saturday will be in the afternoon.

The Plan allows for the opportunity to exercise (2) nonconsecutive twenty minute visitations per week per inmate. It also allows for 1 adult and 1 accompanied minor to visit per visitation. Due to the limited space available in the public side of the visitation room there will only be 3 inmates visiting at one time.

Visitors will be required to complete a COVID screening form provided at the jail and can only visit if the following criteria is met. No contact with a positive person or household within the last 14 days, temperature below 100.4 F and are not expressing symptoms of COVID.

Currently upon arrival new inmates are subject to 16 days of isolation. During this time they are separated from general population. Visitation for inmates in isolation will begin the first day after their release from isolation to general population.

Due to the evolving environment of the Facility a weekly visitation schedule will be posted in the lobby of the Sheriff's Office and on the County Jail website by 6 p.m. each Sunday. If you plan to visit an inmate please bring a mask and arrive 10 minutes before the schedule time of the inmate.

The COVID screening form, Weekly visitation schedule, and the Visitation Addendum are all posted on the Comanche County website under County Jail.
