

## Early Voting By Mail Information

A voter requesting to vote by mail will be required to submit an Application for a Ballot by Mail after January 1, 2023. If you received a ballot by mail for elections held in 2022 your application expired on December 31, 2022 and you will be required to submit an application for 2023. To request an application to vote by mail you may call the Comanche County Clerk's Office at 325-356-2655, visit the County website at [www.co.comanche.tx.us](http://www.co.comanche.tx.us) to complete an application on line or visit the Secretary of State Website at [www.sos.state.tx.us](http://www.sos.state.tx.us) to print an application. Applications for a ballot by mail must be received by the County Clerk by the close of business on April 25, 2023 if you are requesting a ballot for the May 6, 2023 Comanche, DeLeon or Gustine City elections or the DeLeon ISD Election or the Comanche County Consolidated Hospital District Board Election.

A voter may request a ballot by mail if you are age 65 or over, disabled or expected absence from the county during early voting and election day and your ballot may only be mailed to address outside of the county. Voter's age 65 or over may request an Annual Application and receive a ballot for every election they are qualified to vote in for the year 2023. A voter must provide their driver's license number or the last four digits of the social security number on the application to be accepted. This is being required to make elections more secure.
